# (MOB)

Check in at Changi International Airport for your departure flight to Busan.

# DAY 02 SINGAPORE - BUSAN

# (Lunch/Dinner)

Upon arrival at Busan, meet your local guide and begin your Busan tour.

Taejongdae - Located on the tip of the island that juts out from the main coastline. Includes Danubi train ride.

**Gamcheon Culture Village** - It's a colourful village well known for its steep stairs, twisting alleys and cute houses.

Jalgachi Fish Market - The largest seafood market in South Korea, selling both live and dried seafood with great seaview!

**Nampo-dong** - A central commercial and shopping area, consisting of a long north-to-south street with a large walking area with shops, cafes, restaurants, and many more.

**Gukje Market** - Where you'll find food, clothes, handbags, accessories etc. It is said to be similar to Seoul's Namdaemun, with cultural and historical significance.

Seomyeon Street - Central commercial hub of Busan.

# DAY 03 BUSAN

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

**Oryukdo Skywalk** - the highest skywalk in Busan at 37m - giving you the thrill of 'walking in the sky' on the glass observatory.

Haeundae Blue Line Park - a picturesque ecofriendly coastal attraction.

Haeundae Beach - Hop on scenic Blue Line Train ride.

**Cheonsapo** (Daritdol Observatory) - a streamlined observatory inspired by the legend of the blue snake passed down in Cheongsapo.

**Haedong Yonggungsa Temple** - more than just a religious temple - is a mesmerizing attraction with breath-taking panoramic sea views elevating its beauty.

Busan X the SKY Observatory - A transparent glass walking bridge called "Shocking Bridge" also gives you views of Haeundae from directly above. Gwanganli Bridge - View this second longest bridge in the country after Incheon Bridge. Hotel: Busan Crown Harbor or similar



# DAY 04 BUSAN – JEJU ISLAND

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Proceed to airport for your domestic flight to Jeju Island.

Wind 1947 - Get your adrenaline pumping as you coast down the 1,947m-long course. O-Sulloc Green Tea Museum - showcases rich

history of Korean tea within scenic tea farm and the nearby Hallasan Mountain.

Sanbang Mountain Cruise - See the best scenery of Jeju Island from the sea! The cruise ride introduces you to the "four seasons" of Jeju Island near Sanbangsan Mountain.

**Olle Market** - Less touristy place as compared to other traditional markets. Has a nice twist of being a traditional market yet in a hip way!

Seongsan Sunrise Peak - listed centuries ago among the Ten Sights of Yeongju as an ideal place from which to watch the sunrise.

Seongeup Folk Village - an ancient village to learn Jeju's history, culture, and local livelihood.

Trick Art Museum and Ice Gallery - Step into famous masterpieces, experience optical illusion art at six different themed zones.

Yongduam (Dragon Head) Rock - Scenic photostop.

Dongmun Market - Find souvenirs, dried and fresh food, Jeju-only snacks and many more.

Ginseng Shop - Learn all about this widely acclaimed natural product of Korea.

Korean Cosmetic Shop - A multi label shop with that offers diverse products.

Duty Free Shop - A one-stop shopping complex providing over 30 boutiques that offer shoppers a wide range of products.

Myeongdong - One of the primary shopping districts in Seoul with many shops and department stores line the streets and alleys.
