Hwanho Park Space Walk - NOT a rollercoaster, but is a massive sculptural staircase full of dramatic twists and turns. The project is South Korea's largest-ever contemporary public sculpture.

Jukdo Market - A must visit to one of the biggest market in Korea.

Oeosa Temple - Beautiful natural scenery of Unjesan Mountain and the blue water of Oeoji are spectacular.

Homigot Sunrise Plaza - Famous sunrise spot, became famous as the first sunrise spot in the mainland of Korea.

Jagalchi Seafood Market - Largest seafood market in South Korea, selling both live and dried seafood


