Before we end our tour today, make a visit to Bakheng Hill for its beautiful sunset.

# DAY 03 SIEM REAP - PHNOM PENH

#### (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Breakfast at the hotel, transfer to Phnom Penh by Private coach (Approximately 5-6 hours), up on arrival pick up and transfer to have your lunch before check in your hotel. Visit the **Independent** Monument, and the Royal Palace, built by King Norodom in 1866 on the site of the old town, and the Silver Pagoda. Located within the grounds of the Royal Palace, the Silver Pagoda is so named because of its floor, which is made up of 5000 silver tiles. The treasures found inside include a solid gold Buddha encrusted and weighing 90kilograms and a small 17th c. emerald and baccarat crystal Buddha, visit of the Wat Phnom Temple, Phnom Penh's namesake, from where you can enjoy views over the tree-lined avenues of the city and the Notorious Tuol Sleng Museum, In 1975 Tuol Svay Prey High School was taken over by Pol Pot's security forces and turned into a prison known as Security Prison 21 (S-21) till dinner at restaurant and accommodation at hotel. 4\* Duong Chan Hotel or similar

# DAY 3 SIEM REAP - PHNOM PENH

#### (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Breakfast at the hotel, transfer to Phnom Penh by private coach (Approximately 6 hours), up on arrival pick up and transfer to have your lunch before check in your hotel. Pick up from airport transfer to hotel; visit the Royal Palace, built by King Norodom in 1866 on the site of the old town, and the Silver Pagoda. Located within the grounds of the Royal Palace, the Silver Pagoda is so named because of its floor, which is made up of 5000 silver tiles. Lunch at restaurant, visit of the National Museum, also called Musee des Beaux-Arts. A French archaeologist and painter, Georges Groslier, designed it in Khmer style in 1917. The museum contains a collection of Khmer art - notably sculptures - from throughout the ages and the Wat Phnom Temple, Phnom Penh's namesake, from where you can enjoy views over the tree-lined avenues of the city, the Independent Monument, the Sisowath Quay & Naga World Casino till dinner at restaurant.

### DAY 4 PHNOM PENH

# (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Breakfast, visit the Notorious Tuol Sleng Museum, In 1975 Tuol Svay Prey High School was taken over by Pol Pot's security forces and turned into a prison known as Security Prison 21 (S-21) and the Killing Fields of Choeung EK just outside Phnom Penh about a 20-40 minute was an orchard and a Chinese cemetery prior to 1975. During the Khmer Rouge regime it became one of the killing fields. Lunch at restaurant; visit the Russian Market (Psah Tuol Thom Pong), a lively outdoor market where you will find antiquities, silver and gold jewelry, gems, silk, kramas, stone and wood carvings, as well as T-Shirts, CDs and other souvenirs
